## **IASLIC Bulletin :** *Publication Ethics*

IASLIC is always in favour of promoting integrity in research and its publication ethics. Thus, the publication policy for IASLIC Bulletin are framed following the guidelines of different agencies like Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE) (<u>https://publicationethics.org</u>), to guide authors, reviewers, members of the Advisory Board and Editorial Board and the publisher. Of important issues, some are worth noting here –

- (i) All the information related to the submitted manuscripts are kept confidential prior to its publishing;
- (ii) Simultaneous publication of the same article in more than one journal is a breach of publication ethics;
- (iii) Each article submitted for publication must be accompanied with a plagiarism test report within the justified limit of similarity index.

In addition, the editorial board reserves the right to use any plagiarism detecting software to screen the submitted papers at any time for its satisfaction.
