Award for Health Science e-Library

Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences (NTRUHS) has been recognised as having the second highest usage of medical educational resources among 70 members of the Electronic Resources in Medicine (ERMED-India) Consortium managed by the National Medical Library, New Delhi, according to a report published in *The Hindu*. The award was presented at the National Seminar on 'E-Resources in Health Science-Role of ERMED Consortium' held in New Delhi recently. NTRUHS Vice-Chancellor T Ravi Raju said in a press release that the university had established an Electronic Medical Library two years ago for strengthening medical education and to increase the readership among students and faculty. NTRUHS distributes nearly 6,000 medical journals and 400 textbooks free of cost through its electronic gateway to students and also faculty at all affiliated medical and dental colleges. The first author will get a token sum of Rs. 3100 and a shawl, while the co-authors will get a certificate each.

Digital Platform to Provide Books to Every Child

With more than 800 languages spoken in India, access to written stories in every native tongue is limited. In Himachal Pradesh, about 45 miles from the Dalai Lama's residence, lies a village called Suja, where Tibetan Children's Villages is located. While the school's library has enough books for teens in their native language, contemporary, entertaining material for younger readers is completely missing. "Books for primary grades have hardly

been written in Tibetan," says Tenzin Dhargyal, a senior English teacher at TCV School. A few months ago, Dhargyal discovered StoryWeaver, a digital storehouse of multilingual books for kids where users can read, write, translate, modify, and even download books. He fell in love with it. "It has so many relatable stories for children," he says. Dhargyal requested Tibetan script be added to the platform, and in no time he had translated the first story and was using it with his students. Seeing his work, a few more Tibetan educators jumped onto the bandwagon. Today, StoryWeaver has 52 stories in Tibetan, of which Dhargyal will soon be printing three into books for his library. And this month, his secondary school students will be introduced to StoryWeaver so that they can translate at least one book as part of their winter break homework. Tibetanlanguage speakers are not the only ones benefiting from this first-of-its-kind open-source publishing platform. Suchana, a community group that focuses on education and health, is translating stories on Story Weaver in Santali and Kora, two tribal languages that lack written stories. Changing Role of Libraries

A new survey of approximately 1,000 participants sponsored by McGraw-Hill Education that indicates the librarian-faculty relationship is strong. However, a disconnect exists between what faculty perceives is the role of a library and what usage statistics from libraries shows. This discrepancy in perceived value and actual usage is the real issue: There is misalignment in what makes libraries most useful, and therefore misalignment in how their success should be measured and how budgets should be allocated, the report on the survey stresses. Librarians on Information Literacy

Only about one-quarter of librarians say their libraries support information literacy instruction, even though virtually all of them believe it has a positive impact on graduation rates and success in the work force, a new study by the library-service provider ProQuest has found. The

217 high school and college librarians surveyed also said they were not sure if library visitors understood the importance of being able to find, analyse and incorporate information - only 21.2 per cent of the respondents said so, compared to the 34.1 per cent who disagreed. While most of the surveyed librarians (90.8 per cent) said that they taught information literacy skills through one-on-one sessions with visitors, many librarians (42.4 per cent) said that they lacked a way of assessing visitors' level of information literacy. Supreme Court wants Net 'Firewall'

The Supreme Court has recently directed Internet search engines Google, Microsoft and Yahoo and social media Facebook and WhatsApp to develop a "firewall" of the kind evolved in China to prevent by default the uploading of offensive material, like rape and gang-rape videos, says a report published in *The Telegraph*. The court granted them three weeks to come out with the mechanism, brushing aside a plea by Google and others that they would remove such material within "48-72 hours" of receiving a complaint. Kindle to support e-books in five Indian languages

Amazon's e-book reader, Kindle will now support content in five Indian languages, including Hindi, Gujarati and Malayalam, a move that will help the US-based firm tap into the niche but growing 'digital regional content' market in India, says a PTI report published in *The Hindu*. "We are adding thousands of digital books in Hindi, Tamil, Marathi, Gujarati and Malayalam, including the largest digital selection of best sellers, hundreds of exclusive titles and free classics to the Kindle Book Store," Amazon Kindle Director (Content) Sanjeev Jha told PTI. Readers can access these books on Kindle eReaders as well as the free Kindle apps for Android and iOS, he added. "Subscribers of Kindle Unlimited will also have access to the Indian language content. The new language selection is in addition to over three million books that are already available on the Kindle Book Store", he said. OBITUARY

Dr. Shyamal Kr. Roychoudhury, President, Bengal Library Association (BLA); and Vice-President, Physiological Society of India and South Asian Association of Physiologists, passed away on January 13, 2017. An M Sc in Physiology and Ph D (in Biochemistry) degree holder of the University of Calcutta, Dr. Roychoudhury started his career as a Lecturer in Physiology in Tamralipta College, Tamluk, West Bengal, in 1969 and retired as Head of the Department of Physiology of that college in 2001. He passed Certificate in Library Science examination of BLA in 1963 and B Lib Sc examination of the University of Calcutta in 1970. He served as a Guest Faculty in DLIS, Jadavpur University for many years and also as Guest Faculty in Physiology in three universities, viz., University of Calcutta, Presidency University, Kolkata and Kalyani University, Kalyani. He also served as a teacher of Certificate Course in Library Science of BLA and also as the Director of Training Course of that organization. He was the editor of the monthly organ of BLA, *Granthagar*, during 2002-2007 and also Executive Editor of *Indian Journal of Physiology and Allied* Sciences. He was a life member of BLA, ILA and IASLIC. He was first elected as President of BLA in 2014 and re-elected in 2016. He served the organization in that capacity till his death. He was also very close to IASLIC and served as its Election Officer twice. In a condolence meeting organized by BLA and IASLIC in Kolkata on January 28, 2017 to mourn his death, rich tributes were paid to the departed soul.

Shri S G Bhat, former Sr. Assistant Director and Head, Library and Documentation Division, National Environmental Engineering Research Institute (NEERI), Nagpur, passed away on January 21, 2017 at Nagpur at the age of 83. He started his career as a sub-editor of Indian National Bibliography (Marathi Section), at Central Reference Library, Kolkata, in 1961. He joined NEERI (then known as Central Public Health Engineering Research Institute) as Senior Technical Assistant in 1964. Subsequently, he was promoted successively to the posts of Documentation Officer, Sr. Documentation Officer, and Assistant Director and finally retired as Sr. Assistant Director and Head, Library and Documentation Division in July 1993. As the In-charge and later as Head of Library and Documentation Division, he developed the library as an information centre of high repute in the field of Environmental Science and Engineering both at National and International level. The United Nations Environment Program (UNEP) designated NEERI as a special sectoral source of information in Environmental Engineering and Science. He introduced a number of documentation services and developed information products, which received appreciation in the country and abroad. He was awarded WHO fellowship, under which he visited UK, France, Switzerland and Ireland to study environmental information systems of those countries. He was also conferred Associateship of the Institute of Information Scientists (London). He was actively associated as a project leader for a UNEP sponsored project, which resulted in the compilation of "Directory of Institutions in the ESCAP region, active in environmental quality monitoring". International Reference Centre (IRC) on community water supply and sanitation, The Hague, Netherlands, invited him as a consultant at IRC, to prepare a monograph and conduct regional workshop on "Program on Exchange and Transfer of Information (POETRI) at Lima (Peru). Shri Bhat also served as a visiting faculty of DLIS, RTM Nagpur University for 20 years. IASLIC deeply mourns his death.
