#### **Call for Papers**

The IASLIC 34<sup>th</sup> All India Conference 2025 will be organised in collaboration with the Department of Library & Information Science, Karnataka State Akkamahadevi Women University, Vijayapura, Karnataka, India and is scheduled to be held at the Department of Library & Information Science, Karnataka State Akkamahadevi Women University, Vijayapura, Karnataka during January 5-7, 2026.

India aims to debut herself as a developed counter by its centennial anniversary of independence in 2047 encompassing overall growth through sustainable societal advancement with stronger knowledge economy. Transformative education with a modern approach has been brought intending to move towards a better knowledge society reforming the future teaching-learning endeavour by implementing NEP2020. It needs transformation of libraries and information systems onto a balanced modern resource management system enabling marginal poor, youths, women empower. LIS professionals face both tremendous opportunities and challenges to address such transformation. On the one hand, it facilitates global collaboration, improves accessibility, incorporates cutting-edge technologies, and enables customising user experiences. On the other hand, issues like digital divide, infrastructural constraints, information overload, data security, and the requirement of specialised skills are major hindrances. LIS professionals must prioritise user orientation and digital literacy, work with international networks, invest in strong digital infrastructures, and concentrate on ongoing professional development training programs. Libraries must also address issues with intellectual property, digital preservation, and legal compliance. Overcoming these obstacles, libraries would be able to fulfil their role as emerged knowledge centres and contribute in making India a truly developed nation by 2047. Libraries can make a substantial contribution to the goal of bringing out our country a knowledge-driven, digitally inclusive nation.

Keeping the above in considerations, IASLIC has selected 'Library Vision 2047' as the main theme of its 34<sup>th</sup> All India Conference 2025 expecting the LIS professionals to delve upon ongoing important issues of opportunities and challenges that would result with fruitful outcomes and guidelines out of the deliberations and discussions. - Contributed papers must have to be of qualitative value for publishing in the IASLIC Special Publication (ISSN 0972-3668) Volume 62, a peerreviewed post-Conference publication. A generalised presentation, thus, should be avoided.
- 2. Full research paper within 2500 words (not more than 10 pages of A4 paper-size), along with an informative abstract (between 300 and 400 words), typed in double space on single side, in Times New Roman 12pt font size, with margin of 1.5" on all sides should be submitted in **duplicate** (hard copy) by September 15, 2025.
- 3. Authors' declaration in prescribed format for the Conference must be signed by all author(s) sequentially and submitted along with the full paper indicating distinctly the sub-theme and topic of the paper.
- 4. Declaration by the author(s) should be made separately in a hardcopy that the paper has not been sent elsewhere for publication/ presentation.
- 5. Softcopy of the full paper composed in word format (.doc/.docx) should be submitted as an attachment through e-mail to <a href="mailto:iaslic.sem@gmail.com">iaslic.sem@gmail.com</a>.
- For bibliographical references and citations, contributors are required to follow strictly the IASLIC Authorship Manual including Standard and Specification

- 7. The paper should be accompanied with an amount of Rs 1200.00 (Rupees one thousand two hundred only) as non-refundable paper submission fee. - 8. Once a paper is submitted, any kind of changes in authorship is not permissible.
- Pre-Conference abstract volume will include only informative abstracts of accepted papers.
- 10. All accepted papers will be invited for presentation either in the main thematic sessions of the Conference or in the SIG Meetings. Each

- presenter will be allowed maximum fifteen minutes for presentation, including introduction and conclusion.
- 11. There will be provision for Poster presentation. All papers accepted for poster presentation will be allocated time for display of full papers. Abstracts of all papers accepted for poster presentation will be included in the pre-Conference volume.
- 12. There will be a provision for the Best Poster Presentation Award which is likely to be included in the post-Conference volume. Other Poster papers will not be published in the post-Conference volume.
- 13. Accepted papers which are presented in the Conference, will only be considered for publishing in the Post-Conference IASLIC Special Publication (ISSN 0972-3668) Volume 62 subject to its merit of publication. IASLIC Special Publication 2025 is likely to be published within three months after the Conference.
- All registered participants will receive Post-Conference IASLIC Special Publication (ISSN 0972-3668) Volume 62 free of cost from IASLIC office.
- 15. Those who wish to purchase the volume through post, an amount of Rs.150/- will be charged for packaging and postage in addition to its cost price.
